I am pleased to have this opportunity to write a letter of recommendation on behalf of Anna Wiechmann. I have known Anna in two capacities throughout her undergraduate studies. I have been both her academic advisor and her college professor in three of her upper level required courses for her English major.

As her academic advisor, I can report that Anna is highly organized, setting goals for herself, planning her sequence of studies carefully, asking questions, and acting on advice, including advice from the Education Department.

Anna immediately impressed me with her commitment to her content and licensure studies, her organizational skills, and her ability to plan for the future.
