

Explanation Paper:

While doing my clinical at Franklin Elementary in Mankato, MN the students were reading a book in their literacy class. The students then had to use [Fakebook](#) to act as a character in the story. The students were able to chose who they wanted to be from the story. The students then had to post as that character while reading the story. They were to have at least six posts showing what the character might have said during the story. The students also had to comment at least three times on other students pages in a way that their character would have responded.
